## 60 YEARS OF AVANT-GARDE

In 1965, while Le Corbusier, Pierre Jeanneret and Charlotte Perriand were still alive, Cassina began producing their first four groundbreaking furniture models. Working closely with experts and historians, the company's Research and Development Centre meticulously studied the historical drawings, first presented to the public in 1929 at the revolutionary interior design installation *L'Équipement intérieur d'une habitation* at the Salon d'Automne in Paris. Through technical expertise and a forward-thinking approach, Cassina transformed these handcrafted pieces into industrially produced icons, paving the way for their global success. Since then, the collection has continually evolved with the support of the Le Corbusier Foundation and the heirs of Perriand and Jeanneret, incorporating new products, innovations and circular materials—always with the upmost respect of the spirit of the originals.

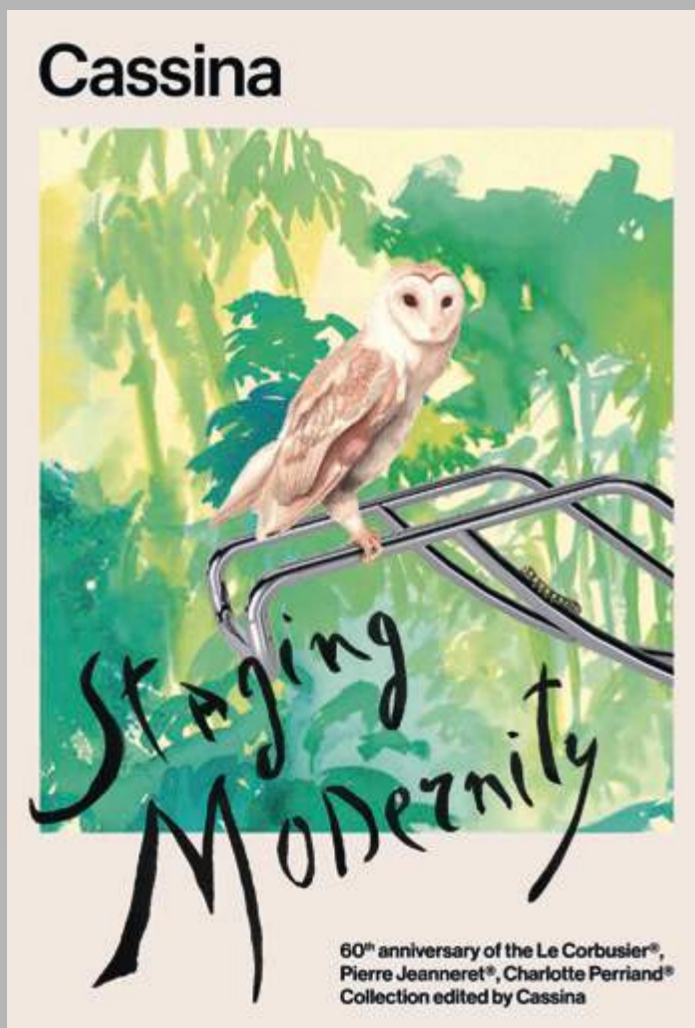
To celebrate the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of production, the first four models of the Le Corbusier<sup>®</sup>, Pierre Jeanneret<sup>®</sup>, Charlotte Perriand<sup>®</sup> Collection are now available for a limited time in three new glossy colourways—red, blue and green—paired with ton-sur-ton mohair velvet for the armchairs and saddle leather for the chaise-longue and sling-back armchair. Developed in collaboration with the Le Corbusier Foundation and the heirs of Jeanneret and Perriand, these special editions—part of the “durable” series made with circular materials—emphasise the designers’ use of colour while offering a fresh and contemporary take on these iconic pieces, available until September 2026.



## STAGING MODERNITY

During Milan Design Week 2025, Formafantasma presented *Staging Modernity* at the Teatro Lirico Giorgio Gaber—a theatrical performance and installation that marks the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Le Corbusier<sup>®</sup>, Pierre Jeanneret<sup>®</sup>, Charlotte Perriand<sup>®</sup> Collection with a critical and evocative reflection on the legacy of Modernism. Taking the iconic Salon d'Automne floor plan as a point of departure, the project deconstructed the ideals of modernity, domesticity and rational design by scattering its elements like fragments of a once-unified vision. Rather than offering a nostalgic reconstruction, Formafantasma reinterpreted modernism as a layered, unstable narrative—one where the boundaries between human and non-human, industrial and primitive, are questioned and reimagined.

In the theatre's foyer, visitors began a didactic journey through the history of the Le Corbusier®, Pierre Jeanneret®, Charlotte Perriand® Collection via a timeline of images, videos and archival material. On stage, Cassina's new limited-in-time editions invited the audience to sit and watch the installation unfold below, in the theatre stalls, where historic pieces were shown alongside 1929 Salon d'Automne reproductions, crafted in the original colours and materials. Throughout the week, performances directed by Fabio Cherstich animated the space, with actors interpreting texts by Emanuele Coccia, Andrés Jaque and Feifei Zhou (terriStories), expanding the experience beyond the visual into a deeper exploration of modernity's legacy.

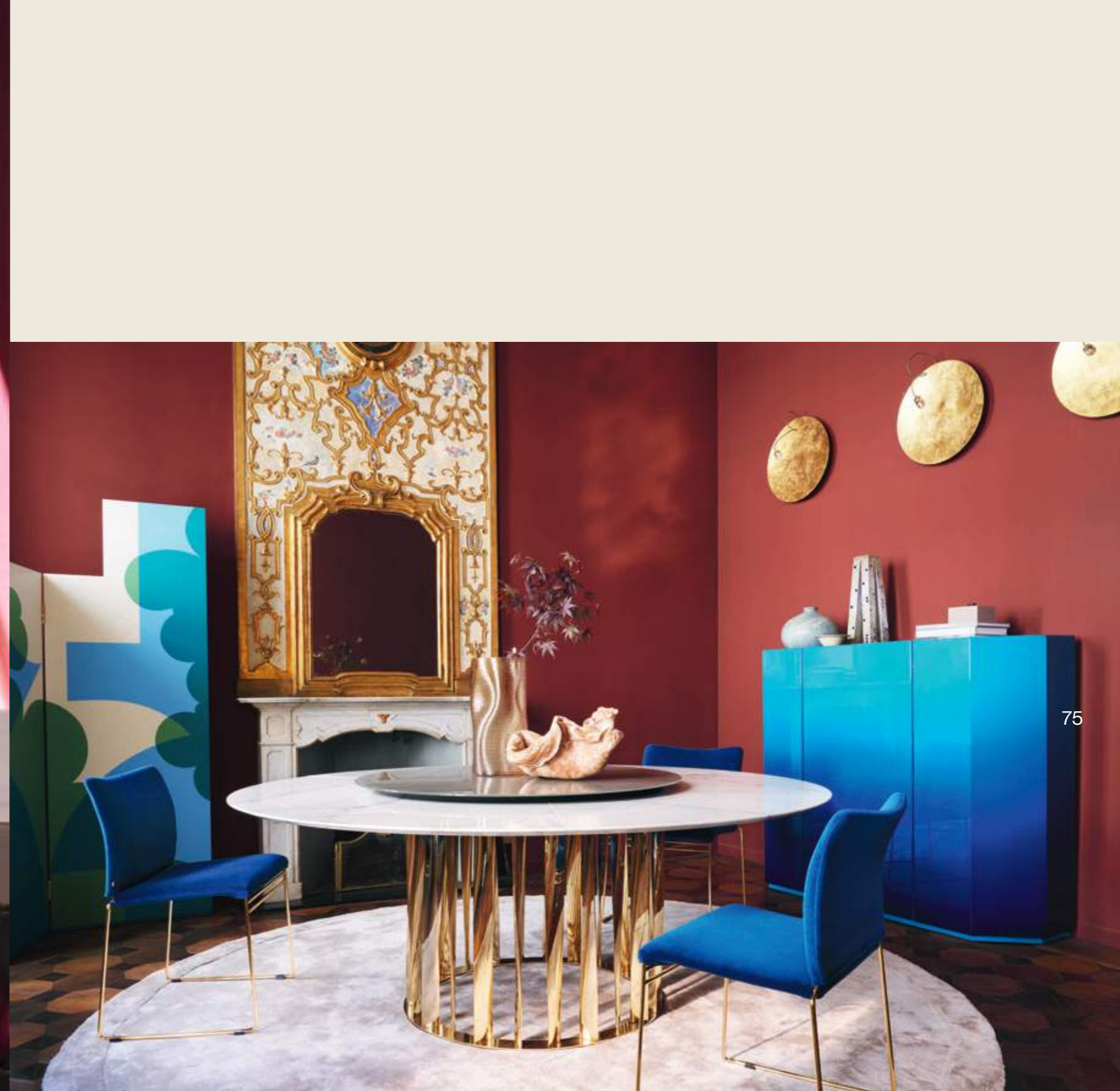

The Sestiere vases are a contemporary tribute to the Venetian art of glass. Hand-blown in Murano glass and wrapped in coloured cords, each vase expresses the perfect union of tradition and experimentation. Vivid, tactile and one of a kind, they celebrate the beauty of imperfection and the enduring charm of craftsmanship.



HOOPTICAL

With Hooptical, Bethan Laura Wood turns reflection into design. Coloured glass semicircles overlap in a hypnotic play of light, transforming the mirror into a living sculpture—vibrant by day, softly radiant by night. An encounter between technology and handcraft, Hooptical captures the poetry of glass and the movement of light in space.

Designed in 1966 for the Japanese ambassador's residence in Paris, Paravent Ambassade expresses the balance between craftsmanship and architecture. Composed of solid wood blocks linked by metal tie rods, it can be arranged freely to create movement and lightness—a sculptural screen that reveals and conceals, engaging in a quiet dialogue with space.

A CONSTELLATION OF VISIONS

The Cassina Lighting Collection is a celebration of creativity, research and timeless design. For Cassina, light is not simply a functional element but a narrative tool that enhances atmosphere and transforms the perception of space. The collection embodies the brand's ability to weave together history and innovation, artisanal know-how and technological progress. Bringing together re-editions and brand-new projects by international designers, the catalogue expands each year, creating a universe of luminous objects that reflect The Cassina Perspective. Sculptural yet versatile, poetic yet rational, these designs express a balance between past and present, revealing the infinite possibilities of light in dialogue with architecture and contemporary living.

DOT PATTERN LIGHT

Originally conceived in 1949 and brought into production thanks to Cassina's meticulous research, the Galaxy lamp is a burst of light suspended in space. Thirty-six stems extend from a central sphere, each one radiating with customised LED sources that evoke the image of a constellation. Available in two sizes and refined finishes, Galaxy is both a technical achievement and a poetic vision, a luminous sculpture that captures the imagination and enhances grand interiors with a striking sense of rhythm and scale.

Inspired by the celebrated Dot Pattern textile designed in 1947, this lighting collection translates the Eames' most iconic graphic motif into a three-dimensional language. Lines and dots intersect to form compositions reminiscent of music, geometry and the designers' own furniture. With wall-mounted and suspension versions, each lamp balances industrial rigour with playful elegance. The result is a family of lights that respects the Eames' original vision while introducing it into contemporary domestic life with clarity and refinement.

TSAI LIGHT

A playful yet sophisticated object, the Palpebra table lamp embodies Ico Parisi's exploration of movement and perception. Designed in 1970, the lamp recalls the gesture of an eyelid opening and closing, thanks to a refined system that allows the upper hemisphere to rotate and modulate the beam of light. Revived by Cassina in close collaboration with the Ico Parisi Archives, Palpebra combines chromatic intensity with technological innovation, transforming a historic design into a contemporary piece of functional poetry.

With Tsai Light, the Chinese designer Mario Tsai transforms a simple form into a modular lighting system of striking clarity. Echoing the logic of building bricks, each block becomes a source of light, composing different architectural configurations that range from minimal to expressive. Whether table or suspension, Tsai Light celebrates rational construction, bringing an industrial yet intimate presence to interiors. Marking Tsai's debut for Cassina, the project affirms the brand's commitment to nurturing emerging international voices.

IRIDE

Neri&Hu's 3to9 system is an elegant tribute to the artisanal tradition of Chinese kite-making. Light, fabric and wire come together in a composition that suggests flight and freedom, diffusing a gentle glow through translucent panels. Offered in modular elements that can be combined in multiple ways, 3to9 is both versatile and poetic, allowing endless arrangements for walls, ceilings or floors. Through this design, Neri&Hu captures the spirit of celebration while enriching everyday interiors with refinement and grace.

Sculptural and futuristic, Iride is the only floor lamp designed by Ico Parisi, reissued thanks to the study of a unique 1970 prototype preserved in his archives. Its tall column of stacked discs conceals a powerful LED source, creating a luminous tower that shifts in tone from cool to warm at the wave of a hand. Available in polished aluminium or glossy red, Iride reflects Parisi's passion for bridging art, design and architecture. A statement piece, it embodies both technological innovation and playful experimentation.

Cassina LAB was launched in 2020, a project born from a collaboration with POLI.design at the Milan Polytechnic, to promote a more conscious design process. For Cassina, this concept is achieved through identification of innovative materials to be employed in the manufacture of products, which have an increasing focus on disassemblability, and in the development of designs able to offer functions that enhance wellbeing.

## 1. TIMELESS DESIGN

The best designs stand out for their ability to last over time, with an enduring aesthetic that transcends trends.

## 2. CIRCULARITY

A design concept oriented towards researching innovative, circular materials for use in product manufacturing that focuses particular attention on product disassemblability, facilitating the recovery and recycling of materials at end-of-life.

Designed by Patricia Urquiola, the Mon-Cloud system introduces a new perspective on upholstered furniture. With no glued parts and a percentage of foamed elements in **CIRCULARREFOAM®** reduced to a minimum, Mon-Cloud is **99.85% disassemblable** at the end of its lifecycle. The model features a metal skeleton wrapped in quilted cushioning made from recycled polyester fibre, enveloping the backrest, armrests and seat.

Cassina offers a new glimpse of the iconic 1973 Cornaro by Carlo Scarpa. Defined by its sculptural wooden frame and soft cushions, it has been reengineered paying special attention to the use of **innovative materials**, such as elements made of **polyurethane with a percentage of polyols derived from biological sources** and **CIRCULARREFOAM®**. 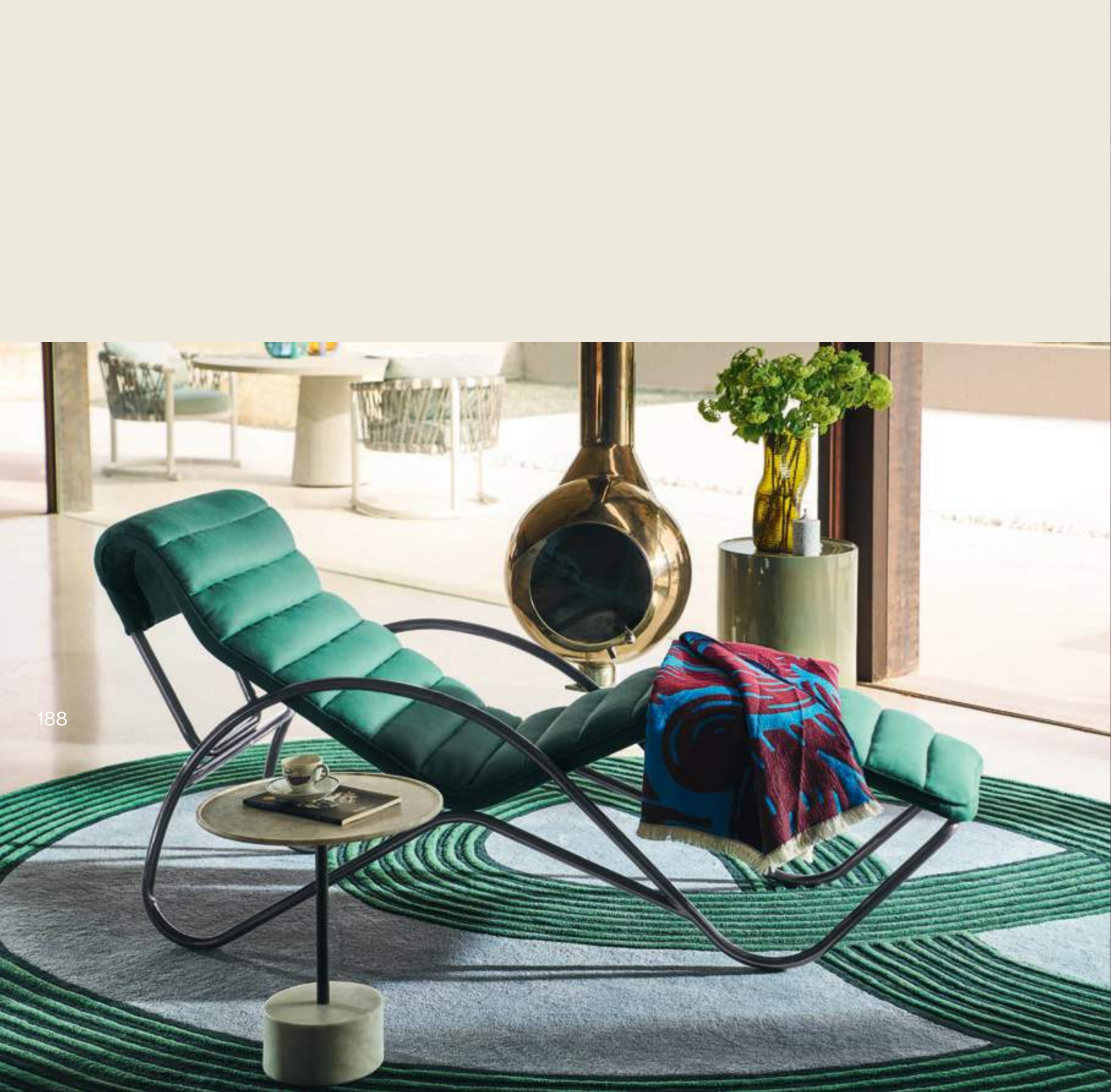

## A CULTURAL MISSION

Cassina's commitment to design has never been confined to objects alone. Over the decades, the company has emerged as a cultural protagonist—an active agent in fostering dialogue between design, art, architecture and the wider social sphere. This chapter explores how Cassina transcends the boundaries of production to promote a deeper, collective reflection on how we inhabit space, perceive ourselves, and engage with the legacy of the masters.

As Beatriz Colomina and Mark Wigley suggest in *Echoes: Cassina. 50 Years of iMaestri* (Rizzoli, 2023), seating design—seemingly static—becomes a tool for repositioning ourselves in the world. Through reinterpretations of modern icons and the staging of these pieces in museum-like contexts, Cassina demonstrates how furniture can act as both object and idea:

a medium through which we think critically about the past, the present and the future. This multifaceted role takes shape across different initiatives: from the reactivation of Carlo Scarpa's historic Biglietteria for La Biennale di Venezia, where architecture became a site for planetary dialogue, to the introspective irony of Pietro Terzini's ME FROM OUTSIDE mirror collection, which uses design to question the way we look at ourselves—and let others look at us.

In parallel, Cassina continues its long-standing support for emerging talents, entrusting artists and designers with the task of imagining new ways of shaping matter, light and emotion. Through its Patronage programme, the brand fosters experimentation and authorship, ensuring that the cultural dimension of design remains alive, generative and open to transformation.

# BIGLIETTERIA SCARPA

Inspired by an original sketch of the interiors by Carlo Scarpa, Patricia Urquiola brought this vision to life by designing two semicircular benches, produced by Cassina Custom Interiors, echoing the rhythm of the ticket office's architecture. The setting was completed by icons from the Cassina catalogue, such as the Mexique stools by Charlotte Perriand and the Modular Imagination poufs by Virgil Abloh.

As part of the 19<sup>th</sup> International Architecture Exhibition of La Biennale di Venezia, curated by Carlo Ratti, Cassina renewed its commitment to promoting design culture through the reactivation of the Biglietteria Scarpa ticket office, an architectural landmark of the lagoon city, designed by Carlo Scarpa in 1952.

The work of the Venetian master came back to life with “Voice of Commons”, a Special Project of the Biennale conceived by architect and activist Giulia Foscari and her dual agency UNA-UNLESS, under the patronage of UNESCO, the United Nations Decade of Ocean Science for Sustainable Development and the European Space Agency. Throughout the duration of the Biennale, the historic ticket office became a space for dialogue dedicated to Humanity’s Global Commons: Antarctica, the Ocean, the Atmosphere and Outer Space—with a rich programme of talks and podcasts.



# ME FROM OUTSIDE

The dialogue between these two worlds is continuous: following numerous teasing initiatives, ME FROM OUTSIDE was revealed during Milan Design Week 2025 in the Cassina Store Milan where a striking installation was staged in a room full of mirrors. The reflection of each mirror was infinitely amplified, encouraging visitors to post their photo on social media, thus becoming a medium to vehicle Terzini’s vision.

A symbol of reflection, introspection and vanity, the mirror is not only a practical tool but an object that presents us with a complex encounter, between what we see and what we feel and between how we see ourselves reflected and how we are perceived by others.

Italian artist Pietro Terzini is well-known for his works that, through bold handwritten phrases, provoke us to interact and reflect. This pop art approach has been developed in collaboration with Cassina to launch his first design product that has the main objective of questioning its user.

Thanks to its great artistic potential, the mirror is a powerful vehicle for communication. The ME FROM OUTSIDE collection is a visual narrative that stimulates reflection on ourselves and the society in which we live. Characterised by a contemporary aesthetic, the large oval mirror has been screen-printed with messages in capital letters that create a direct relationship between the user and the object itself.



# PATRONAGE

## LINDE FREYA TANGELDER Soft Corners



Soft Corners, the first furniture collection by Linde Freya Tangelder for Cassina, blends sculptural softness with architectural rigor. Developed within the Patronage program and born from the designer's experimental work during her IN Residence experience, the collection features interlocking poufs made of padded rubber and wood, designed for disassembly and repair. Complementing them is a steel coffee table with clean lines and concealed joints, echoing the poufs' forms while adding textural contrast and full recyclability. This collaboration, enriched by Cassina's cultural support in the production of her own hand-made collectable editions, also led to Tangelder's first solo show and a monograph published by Nero Editions.

Patronage, a centuries-old practice typical of the Italian Renaissance, was the driving force in the development of the arts. Thanks to the support provided, artists were able to freely express their creativity without limits, contributing to the history of art as we know it today. In the design field, the Cassina Research and Development Centre has represented a similar launch pad for many young talents, becoming a hub for exploring innovative ideas and experimenting with new materials and production processes. With the Patronage project, Cassina resumes this approach and starts a new chapter in its history.

**LINDE FREYA TANGELDER**

Wax, Stone, Light

Wax, Stone, Light is the evolution of Linde Freya Tangelder's exploration of sculptural form and material transformation. Rooted in the research behind her first solo exhibition supported by Cassina, the collection reinterprets the concept of stacked architectural volumes through five totemic columns made from Murano glass. Each cube is hand-shaped using wax and cast in iron moulds, then assembled around a central LED tube that radiates a soft glow through off-white or smoky grey tones. The result is not just a lamp, but a luminous, tactile atmosphere.

Expanding on her poetic exploration of material and light, Linde Freya Tangelder's Wax, Stone, Light collection also includes three models designed to illuminate larger spaces: a pendant lamp and two wall appliques—one rounded, the other linear—crafted from sculptural glass cubes. As with the original pieces, each block is mouth-blown in Murano glass and hand-shaped with wax, preserving its unique texture. Born from the designer's fascination with the transformation of liquid into solid, this evolving collection continues Tangelder's creative journey with Cassina as part of the Patronage project, reaffirming the brand's commitment to supporting experimental, international talent.

Polyshape, Ferréol Babin's debut project for Cassina, merges sculpture and functionality in a refined balance of geometry, colour and minimalism. Available as both a floor and table lamp, its clean forms—cylindrical base, rectangular stem and head—are rendered in matte metallic hues with no visible dimmer connections, highlighting the object's formal purity. The floor version also includes an upward-facing spotlight for versatile lighting.

Part of Cassina's Patronage initiative and developed in collaboration with IN Residence, Babin's work reflects a handcrafted, artistic sensibility. During Milan Design Week 2025, his Passage stools—acquired following his solo show at Friedman Benda in Los Angeles—were on view in the Cassina Store's dome.

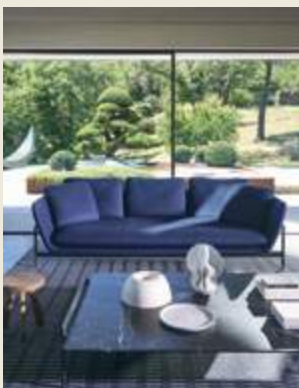
